

New Hall Pinot Gris 2014 Reserve, purleigh Essex

Youthful mix of spice, minerals and tropical fruits. On the palate there is an abundant richness to pure, intense fruit and the finely tuned acidity creates a multi layered mouthful. Poise and verve with subtle steel and structure. and has a lingering finish. This is ideal for current drinking, especially for the spicy character. Producer New Hall is one of England's oldest and largest vineyards, established by the Greenwood family in 1969. A formative stint in Alsace has inspired the winemaker, Piers Greenwood, to produce some remarkably flavoursome, multi-layered still wines. There are seventy-eight hectares of vines at New Hall, planted to no fewer than nineteen varieties, each selected to optimise the potential of its particular site.
