PRODUCER

Settled today in Chassagne-Montrachet, the Domaines Famille Picard was founded in 1951 by Louis Félix Picard. Michel Picard, his son, will join him a few years later. In 1997, Michel took over the estate of Château de Chassagne-Montrachet. Through passion, courage and stubbornness, Michel Picard has built over the years a family winery recognized by his peers. Today, 140 hectares of vines are spread over 4 estates which Francine Picard, his daughter, manages entirely. The whole of the estate is managed in line with organic viticulture, with 30 hectares with biodynamic practices.



VITICULTURE + VINIFICATION

The vineyard is located in Chassagne-Montrachet at an elevation of 250m. It is a poor, very shallow calcareous brown soil, with outcrops of limestone rocks from Ladoix and stones from Dijon Corton. Most of the vines were planted in the mid-1970s. 18 months ageing on lees, including 10 months in oak barrels (Burgundy 228L barrels and 1HL barrels).

TASTING NOTE

The vineyard is located in Chassagne-Montrachet at an elevation of 250m. It is a poor, very shallow calcareous brown soil, with outcrops of limestone rocks from Ladoix and stones from Dijon Corton. Most of the vines were planted in the mid-1970s. The grapes are grown biodynamically.
